



INDIA - E-VISA

Waiting time: up to 72 hours after closing and paying for the application. You must apply for an e-visa no later than 5 days before departure.

Required documentation:

- 1. Tourist E-visa:
 - a scan of passport photo page in PDF format (file size up to 300 kB)
 - a photo as for the Polish biometric passport in electronic version, without glasses, in JPG format (file size up to 300 kB)
 - a completed visa application
- 2. Business E-visa:
 - a scan of passport photo page in PDF format (file size up to 300 kB)
 - a photo as for the Polish biometric passport in electronic version, without glasses, in JPG format (file size up to 300 kB)
 - a completed visa application
 - scan of the business card in PDF format (file size up to 300 kB)

As a standard, we start the verification and application process on the next business day after receiving the set of documents.

E-Visa

The e-visa is issued in the form of electronic authorization. If everything goes well, we will receive a visa "promise", i.e. a document on the basis of which a residence permit will be issued to us at the airport in India.

Attention:

You can use the eVisa only at 29 airports: Ahmedabad, Amritsar, Bagdogra, Bengaluru, Bhubaneshwar, Calicut, Chennai, Chandigarh, Cochin, Coimbatore, Delhi, Gaya, Goa, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Kannur, Kolkata, Lucknow, Madurai, Mangalore, Mumbai, Nagpur, Port Blair, Pune, Tiruchirapalli, Trivandrum, Varanasi & Visakhapatnam, and 5 sea ports: Cochin, Goa, Mangalore, Chennai, Mumbai.

Passport

The passport should normally be valid for a minimum of 6 months from the date of entry into India and must have a minimum of 2 blank pages (without any stamps or slides from other visas), intended for visas and preferably adjacent to each other.

Important: Please check the technical condition of your passport and the number of blank pages. The passport cannot have any technical damage, especially check the condition of the first page with the photograph.
