BASIC INFORMATION

Waiting time:

Approx. 1 week

VISA

Tourist visa:

From February 1, 2019, visa-free travel was introduced for citizens of 45 countries, including Poland. Visa-free travel applies to tourist stays for up to 30 days.

Business visa:

Visa validity period is dependent on the invitation's type and may amount from 7 days up to 1 year.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The passport upon entry to Uzbekistan must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry.
Note: Please make sure that the Border Guard has stamped your entry.

Important:

Please check the technical condition of your passport and the number of blank pages. The passport must not have any technical damages (please check the condition of the first photo page of the passport).

After crossing the border, it is necessary to check in within 3 days. In the case of accommodation in a hotel, registration is made by the hotel staff on our behalf, but each time you should ask for proof of registration, i.e. prospiska. If you are staying with a private individual, you must register yourself with one of the registration offices. In the event that any of the nights will be traveled, keep the ticket with detailed travel information. All evidence of registration collected during the trip must be presented when leaving the country.
